

RESIDENCIES

v.arc has two studio spaces that are allocated for an international resident and a local, Sweden-based resident. The studios are connected to a social space used for discussions, seminars and hospitality. Residents will be artists engaged in a research-based practice and related practitioners from across the spectrum of fine art. Each will undertake research for a concentrated period of time; generally, a minimum of 3 weeks for international resident and 6 weeks for local resident. The strategy for selection is to pair together researchers who are engaged in a similar conceptual and/or theoretical field of interest, but have different points of entry.

Requirements

Those in studio residency will be required:

- To submit a proposal outlining the aims of the project and research strategy during the residency
- To engage with research staff and students at Valand School of Fine Arts
- To deliver an introductory lecture on their work and the research to be undertaken
- To provide content for the blog on the Research Centre's web site
- To deliver one Lunch Bites session to an invited community on a specific topic related to the research/practice
- To contribute to the v.arc archive at the end of the residency. Each resident will submit documentation of their research and practice as a resource for future residents.

What the studio residency will provide:

- A studio space located in v.arc at the Valand School of Fine Arts
- A stipend of 10000SEK (including taxes)
- Accommodation provided in a flat in central Gothenburg (international residents only)
- Travel costs when applicable
- Access to libraries, technical facilities and production equipment
- Integration into Valand School of Arts community of research staff and students, and Gothenburg community of artists and practitioners
